District Conference began with the gathering of God's people - preparing for worship at Burlington United Methodist Family Services Campus (Gym), Burlington, West Virginia. Greetings and Welcome was extended by Rev. Rich Hogg., Chaplain of BUMFS. Prelude was given by the Rainbow Chapel Choir. They sang two songs: "In Christ Alone" and "Make a Joyful to the Lord." As we entered into Worship, Celebration of Mission Events, and the Business of District Conference, District Superintendent Rev. E. Dallas Forren presided.

Worship began with the call to worship, with everyone joining in and singing "Sanctuary" followed by the opening hymn, "Shine, Jesus, Shine." We all joined in the invocation printed in our booklets. Welcome to District Conference and Burlington United Methodist Family Services was extended by the Rev. E. Dallas Forren. He thanked BUMFS for hosting us, introduced Dr. Alex Carmichael, Interm CEO of BUMFS, extended thanks to Rev. Rich Hogg, the Rainbow Chapel Choir, Suzanne Knight for playing the piano, and Burlington Union Church for providing refreshments. Dr. Carmichael said there would be tours of the Burlington Campus after District Conference if anyone would like to do so.

The first order of business was the election of the District Conference Recording Secretary. Barbara Rexroad was nominated and elected by a unanimous voice vote. She was so elected.

The minutes of the previous session of the 2009 District Conference held at Mt. Zion United Methodist Church, on May 3, 2009 were accepted as printed in District booklet by a unanimous yes voice vote.

Rev. Forren directed our attention to the Report of the District Committee on Ordained Ministry on pages 8-10. He asked for questions. There were no questions and the report was approved with a voice vote.

As we celebrated ministry in the Potomac Highland District we recognized the following retirees at this year's Annual Conference: Ann Harrison, Walter C. Mullins, Mary L. Radford, and Lacy Joe Robinette. Recommendations for Provisional Members at Annual Conference this year were Kara D. Rowe and Michael J. Rowe. Certified Candidates approved by Board of Ordained Ministry are Steven D. Davis and Nancy D. Sims. Also at this time he recognized Local and Certified Lay Speakers by asking them to stand. The District had 70 lay speakers attend Christian Academy the past weekend. Lay speaking is very important in the United Methodist Church. Those folks completing Course of Study this year are William A. Durst and Judith M. Stump. We celebrated every one's gift of ministry by singing "Shout to the Lord."

Rev. Forren thanked everyone for the great turnout today for District Conference. He explained about membership in the Burlington United Methodist Family Services Auxiliary. Dues are \$2 per person per year. Half of this money goes into a scholarship fund for young people from BUMFS graduating from high school and planning to go on to college. A lifetime membership can be given for a gift of \$50. He then introduced our guest speaker for the afternoon, Bishop Ernest S. Lyght, our resident bishop. He explained to Bishop Lyght that a lifetime membership had been purchased for him. Barbara Rexroad, President of the Auxiliary, came forward and presented the Bishop with his lifetime membership.

Bishop Ernest Lyght greeted us. He thanked Burlington United Methodist Family Services for all that we do in ministry together. He thanked the Potomac Highland District for all the work and ministry that we do. He then read I Corinthians 13. The Bishop said that many churches that he visits say they are a friendly church, but then asked if they really were? A suggested better question is, are they loving? He then asked, "What is your Church like?" He reminded us that we must follow the leadership of Jesus in our loving of the people. He asked us if our love for Jesus was growing or fainting? He also reminded us of John Wesley's three simple rules for life. Do no Harm, Do Good, and Stay in Love With God. He challenged us to think about where our churches are going. The Hymn of Response was "Lord, I Lift Your Name on High."

Part of our event today is the Celebration of Mission Event (C.O.M.E.). Rev. Forren asked Sandy Binotto, District Mission Coordinator, to come forward. She explained that our mission projects for this year are: Scotts Run Settlement House, The House of the Carpenter, and United Methodist Ministries. We had a speaker from Scotts Run Settlement House. Each of the cooperative parishes in the district collected diapers, baby items, and funding for each of these projects. Offering at District Conference today will also be divided equally among the three missions for the C.O.M.E. event.

Rev. Forren asked that we place registration forms in the offering plates. We sang "Glorify Thy Name" as the offering was lifted. After the offering was received we joined together in A Prayer for Mission.

Rev. Forren talked about the different missions of the district. We have sent about 2,000 Health Kits to Mission Central. We are in mission with many special projects. Sandy Binotto told us during the C.O.M.E. celebration that she had been invited to be a part of a work team going to Haiti. The district agreed to raise \$2,500 to fund the Haiti training mission trip for Sandy.

Rev. E. Dallas Forren referred us to Page 19 "Motion for 2010 District Fund". The motion was unanimously approved by a voice vote to set the 2010 District Fund at three percent (3%) of the pastor's, "Total Appointive Cost" for each charge. We were referred to Page 20 for the Potomac Highland District 2009 Statement of Fund Balances. On Pages 21-24 is a listing of the 2009 Fair Share and District Fund Payout figures. The total Fair Share end of year payout was 92.14% and the total District Fund end of year payout was 93.09%.



The following announcements were made:


- 1) Lay led revival begins on April 25, 2010 for the Mineral Parish "Fanning the Flame." Check the District web site at www.phdumc.com for more details.

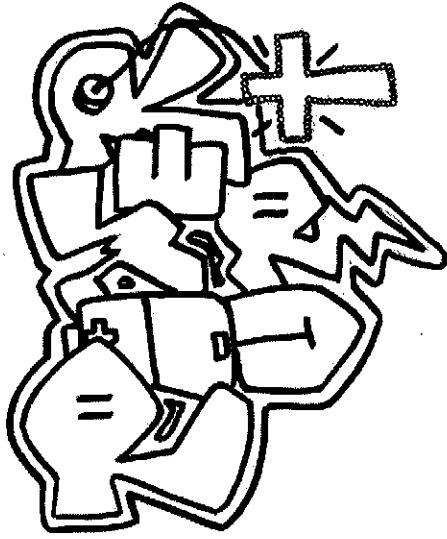

GLENWOOD PARK RETIREMENT VILLAGE

Dealing each day with state and federal regulations has made adjusting to change an ongoing necessity at GlenWood Park Retirement Village. However, a major new change is occurring, one that GlenWood hasn't faced since 1979 – a change in leadership.

Dr. Daniel W. Farley, President/CEO, has announced that he will relinquish the chief executive officer position as of December 31, 2011. At that time, based on approval by the Board of Trustees, he will continue as president for 2012. Rick Shrewsbury began a 12-month contract in January as Apprentice CEO. He earned a degree in health care administration from the Medical College of Virginia and became a licensed nursing home administrator in 1990. He had been employed by AMFM Nursing and Rehabilitation Centers. Rick has roots in Spanishburg and currently resides in Pipestem with his wife and two children. Based on a recommendation from Dr. Farley and approval by the Board of Trustees, he will assume the role of CEO in January.

Physical changes are taking place at GlenWood as the result of a \$1,250,000 bond issue signed with First Community Bank in May 2010, enabling the Village to undergo an extensive renovation project in the 67-bed skilled nursing unit. The project includes the installation of a new heating and cooling system for the entire unit and new domestic water pipes. Additional renovations are taking place in resident rooms, the nurses' station and the day room. The project is expected to be completed this summer.

A generous anonymous donation enabled GlenWood to purchase a new bus in 2010 to transport residents to plays, concerts and other activities in the area. The bus holds 12 passengers in addition to the driver and two wheelchair positions. The new bus features luggage carriers, an extra wide entrance, electric doors and a Braun wheelchair lift.

GlenWood is compiling a cookbook to raise money and increase awareness for the Village's Golden Cross Resident Assistance Fund, created to benefit residents in assisted living who have outlived their financial resources but do not meet the physical criteria for nursing home placement where Medicaid could cover their costs. More and more of GlenWood's residents are living longer than they ever imagined and depleting the money they saved to meet their retirement needs, making the Golden Cross Fund increasingly important.

Learning about what's happening at GlenWood is much easier now with the launch in 2010 of the Village's new website. The address is still www.gwpinc.org, but the look of the site and the amount of information available has changed drastically. Visitors to the site can now access everything from floor plans of various living options to a job application. Marketing Assistant Lisa Fenton frequently updates photographs, calendars, job openings, news stories and other features that keep visitors up-to-date. She also maintains a page for GlenWood on Facebook that alerts friends to fun and interesting facts about the Village.

Visiting GlenWood's website is now a great way to keep up with the Village, but it's no substitute for actually coming to Princeton and seeing firsthand the faces of the residents and staff who are the heart and soul of our ministry. We welcome individuals, families, church groups – anyone who wants to learn more about West Virginia's only faith-based continuing care retirement community.
